

Two individuals, one clergy and one lay-person representing the church, along with the Lector, address the Ordaining Bishop:

Bishop Steven, the people and clergy of the American Old Catholic Church, trusting in the guidance of the Holy Spirit, have chosen Gordon to be their bishop and chief pastor.

His election has been confirmed by the clergy of the church.

We therefore ask you to lay your hands upon him and in the power of the Holy Spirit to ordain and consecrate him a bishop in the One, Holy, Catholic, and Apostolic Church.

The entire assembly responds:







& LAYING ON OF HANDS

The Ordaining Bishop imposes his hands upon the head of the Bishop-elect. This ancient gesture, which expresses the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, is the heart of the Ordination Rite.

SO PRAYER OF CONSECRATION

The Ordaining Bishop places the open Book of the Gospels upon the head of the bishop-elect; two individuals, one clergy, one lay woman (this is a symbolic expression of the synodal balance of the ancient Church), standing on either side of the bishop-elect, hold the Book of the Gospels above his head until the Prayer of Consecration is completed.

All stand.

The New Bishop is led to the chair by the Ordaining Bishop. The Ordaining Bishop then says to the new bishop:

Guard the truth that has been entrusted to you by the Holy Spirit Who lives in us.

The entire assembly responds, saying:

We welcome you as a shepherd of Christ's flock. Build up the Church in unity and love, so that the world may believe.

The New Bishop greets the assembly, saying:


